

Our SAT provides opportunities for parents to be involved in the decision making process for individual students. Parents are informed at least ten days in advance of any such meeting. We reschedule meetings at the request of parents. SAT logs are maintained and teachers are well prepared with data before meetings to present to parents and our SAT coordinator. My office has an open door policy and parents are very aware they may come in my office at any time to discuss their children and school related functions. An annual county parent teacher conference is available. Teachers are also available for individual conferences as requested.

6. The **Nitro Elementary** shall provide each parent an individual student report about the performance of their child on the State assessment in at least math, language arts and reading by:

Along with a letter from Dr. Paine, each child will hand deliver a copy of his WESTEST 2 scores to his parents/guardians in September. WESTEST 2 scores were discussed in the first PTO meeting. DIBELS scores are sent home after each benchmark is complete.

7. The **Nitro Elementary** shall take the following actions to provide each parent timely notice when their child has been assigned or has been taught for four (4) or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who is not highly qualified within the meaning of the term in section 200.56 of the Title I Final Regulations (67 Fed. Reg. 71710, December 2, 2002):

Letters were sent home informing parents of their right to know about Highly Qualified teachers at Nitro Elementary. The principal will complete an annual attestation statement regarding the highly qualified status. All aides are assigned to work under the direct supervision of a teacher. The school handbook provides information concerning the procedures for parents to follow for requesting information about teachers. This regulation was also discussed during our first PTO meeting. We provide a mentoring program through KCS for new teachers. We give support and collaboration to teachers through monthly collaboration meetings.

8. The **Nitro Elementary** shall provide assistance to parents of children served by the school, as appropriate, in understanding topics by undertaking the actions described below --

- the state's academic content standards,
- the state's student academic achievement standards,
- the state and local academic assessments including alternate assessments,
- the requirements of Title I Part A,
- how to monitor their child's progress, and
- how to work with educators:

We provide a minimum of two parents to school days that allow parents to come into the classrooms and observe the educational process with their children. The Edline system provides parents current grades and monitoring of their children's progress.
